

Norfolk Record Office Volunteer Role: Archive Packaging and Seal Sock Group

Location

Norfolk Record Office (NRO) at The Archive Centre.

Time commitment

The group meets for a two-hour session every 4-6 weeks.

Purpose

To assist in the long-term preservation of the NRO's collections by improving the packaging of documents. This may include placing documents into archive-quality enclosures and boxes; removing metal fastenings and rubber bands; surface cleaning documents (if needed); and sewing foam seal socks to protect document seals.

Length of volunteering opportunity

Expected to last for at least six months.

Duties:

- To repackage documents into archive-quality files and envelopes, copying any labels from the original folders to the new ones.
- To remove metal paper clips, rubber bands and other fastenings which damage documents, replacing them with brass paperclips, archive-quality tape or by placing groups of documents into archive-quality enclosures
- To re-box documents into archive-quality boxes and label the boxes
- To compile lists of the box contents, if required
- Basic surface cleaning of documents with a brush, if required
- To sew protective foam seal socks to help preserve document seals.

Skills/experience/personal qualities:

- Ability to handle documents with care, especially any in poor condition, so as not to cause further damage
- Ability to work in a methodical way, maintaining the original order of loose papers as they are found
- Ability to transfer information accurately from old folders and boxes to their replacement enclosures.
- Ability to sew
- An interest in the preservation of archival documents.
